Complementary registrations: A limited number of complementary registrations are available on a first-come, first-served basis for individual patients, carers, members of Support Groups or Voluntary Organisations (limited to two per group/organisation) or cancer charities with an annual budget of less than £500,000 Pounds Sterling (limited to two per charity). Complementary registrations do not include travel or accommodations.

Delegates wishing to apply for one of the complementary places must register by post.

Registration deadline is Friday, 14th November 2008. Registrations received after this date will incur a late registration fee of £25.00 per registration.
